3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. To promote social welfare, ethical leadership, moral education and community service inspired by the teachings, philosophy and values of Bhagwan Swaminarayan, including Satya, Ahimsa, Seva, discipline and selfless service, for the benefit of society at large.
2. To promote preventive healthcare, medical relief, sanitation, nutrition, mental health and environmental health by establishing, maintaining and running hospitals, clinics, dispensaries, primary healthcare centres, tele-medicine facilities, mobile medical units, health camps, blood donation drives and public awareness programs for the benefit of the public, especially the underprivileged.
3. To establish, operate and support education and vocational skill development by running schools, colleges, ashrams, gurukuls, hostels, libraries, research and study centres, skill academies and e-learning platforms; to conduct training, assessment, certification and research for employability, entrepreneurship and sustainable livelihoods.
4. To establish, maintain, run,

assist, manage and support orphanages, widow homes, old-age homes, shelters, rehabilitation centres, short-stay homes, child-care and counselling centres, community kitchens and helplines and other institutions providing food, clothing, medical care and social support to women, children, poor, destitute, elderly, infirm, disabled, abandoned or needy persons.

5. To help alleviate poverty by enabling access to clean nutritious food, safe drinking water, shelter, education and livelihoods for people deprived of such access, and by implementing community and rural development programs.

6. To support, promote and aid the preservation, protection and welfare of cattle and other animals, and to establish, maintain and assist gaushalas, animal shelters and rescue centres for care, treatment and rehabilitation.

7. To preserve and promote Indian arts, culture, traditional crafts, science and sports, including exhibitions, residencies, festivals, workshops and community sports programs for public benefit.

8. To promote environmental sustainability, ecological balance, renewable energy awareness, waste management, conservation of natural resources and biodiversity, and to run training, capacity-building, demonstration projects, audits and certifications that build green skills and livelihoods.

9. To promote ethical values, cultural heritage, moral education, spiritual well-being and universal human values inspired by the Swaminarayan Sampradaya through satsang, study, discourses, publications, retreats and community programmes conducted for the public at large without discrimination.

10. To establish and maintain

places of learning and quiet contemplation, prayer halls, dharmashalas and community facilities to foster ethical living and service, open to the public; and to organize pilgrimages, cultural tours and festivals that promote heritage, service and learning (subject to applicable statutory expenditure caps).

11. To provide scholarships, grants, fellowships, stipends and educational assistance (including travel, boarding and lodging) to deserving students in India or abroad, particularly in health, environment, science, arts, entrepreneurship and public administration.

12. To enable beneficiaries trained or assisted by the Company to access livelihoods through mission-aligned, non-profit platforms (physical/online), fairs and exhibitions incidental to the core charitable objects, for artisan-made, eco-friendly, assistive or health-support products; and to design, produce, procure and distribute such mission-aligned goods and services solely to further the charitable objects and with surplus reinvested (with separate books maintained).

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. To receive donations, subscriptions, CSR funds, grants and foreign contributions in compliance with law (including CSR-1, Sections 12AB/80G of the Income-tax Act and FCRA as applicable).

2. To collaborate with governments, statutory bodies, NGOs, trusts, universities, multilateral and international agencies for achieving the objects.

3. To organize seminars, conferences, workshops, training programs, awareness drives, public campaigns, exhibitions, publications and outreach aligned to the objects.

4. To acquire, lease or license movable or immovable

property; construct, renovate, develop and maintain facilities necessary for the objects.

5. To carry out incidental manufacture, services or sales strictly linked to the charitable programs, maintain separate books of account and apply all surplus solely towards the objects.

6. To open and maintain branches/offices across India; to hire staff, experts and volunteers; and to enter into lawful contracts for program delivery.

7. Any activity in the nature of trade, commerce or business shall be incidental to the charitable objects, conducted with separate books of account, and where applicable under law the aggregate receipts from such activities shall remain within the prescribed threshold to retain tax exemption.

8. The Company shall operate for the benefit of the public at large without discrimination and shall not be expressed to be for the exclusive benefit of any particular religious community or caste. Religious or spiritual expenditure, if any, shall not exceed five percent (5%) of total income in any financial year.

the doing of all such other lawful things as considered necessary for the furtherance of the above objects:

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

4 *The objects of the company extend to the

whole of India.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

6 No alteration shall be made to this memorandum of association or to the articles of association of the company which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar.

7 The liability of the members is limited.

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9 True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the company and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits and liabilities of the company; and, subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the company for the time being in force, the accounts shall be open to the inspection of the members. Once at least in every year, the accounts of the company shall be examined, and the correctness of the balance-sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors

10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.

11 The Company can be amalgamated only with another company registered under section 8 of the Act and having similar objects.
